RE: Legislative Information 2010

The One-Hundred First Legislature, Second Session, convened on Wednesday, January 6, 2010. A copy of the 2010 Legislative Session Calendar can be found on the Nebraska Unicameral's website which is <http://www.nebraskalegislature.gov>. Legislation will be introduced through the 10th legislative day, January 21, 2010. There have been a total of 164 bills and 4 constitutional amendments introduced during the first 3 days of the session.

The list of oneliners of bills introduced is available daily on the Legislature's website. Proceed to the website, go to "Bills and Laws" and then click "Search Bills." Next scroll down to "Search by Date of Introduction." Click on the downward arrow and scroll to and highlight January 6th, the first day of bill introduction, and then click "Search." To check bills introduced, click on the appropriate date (January 6 thru January 21) you are interested in reviewing, then "Search" and you will be provided with the bill numbers and description of bills introduced on that day.

We will be flagging those bills we believe will be of interest to you and will provide you a list next week. Please notify us of any legislative proposals that may be of particular interest to you, and we will add those bills to the computer printout that we update throughout the session and send to you at the end of each week.

On January 11, the Legislature will begin debating carryover legislation from the 2009 Session. Governor Heineman will deliver the State of the State Address on January 14. Legislative committee hearings will begin January 19, and the Chief Justice will deliver the State of the Judiciary on January 21.
