The Twin Loups Reclamation District, Scotia, Nebraska is looking to fill the General Manager position in 2023. The position will be responsible for working with two Boards of Directors and a staff of 10 people. The position is located in Scotia, Nebraska and the surface water Irrigation Project is owned by the Bureau of Reclamation. The Project serves approximately 55,000 acres with water diverted from the Calamus River through the use of two Reservoirs, Calamus and Davis Creek, into a canal system serving its water users. This is a very challenging position that will require experience in public relations, governmental relations, financial expertise in preparing budgets, coordinating programs to help fund and benefit the District's long term needs which will include writing and securing grant funding. The position will include working with Bureau of Reclamation for renewing a long-term contract for water service or potentially buying all the water supply works from the federal government.
